Specific tasks being performed by TBC Solutions for this project include:

- Coordination with various interagency taskforces commissioned by the WFLC to formulate goals, performance measures, and implementation tasks associated with the 10-Year Comprehensive Strategy Implementation Plan.
- Development of publication of interim and final reports that summarize the progress of the Cost Action Taskforce commissioned to implement actions related to reduction of large wildland fire suppression costs.
